

An Introduction to an Advanced Decision-making Framework

This **1-day workshop** has been developed as an introduction to a framework for reasoning and decision-making developed to support public sector practitioners in their day-to-day decisions. It is ideal for individuals/teams who are exploring the possibility of using this approach. For more in-depth training in the framework which will support direct work-based the application of the principles, the two-day workshop is recommended.

Please note: This workshop does not equip services/teams/organisations to implement the model locally. More in-depth training is required for this.

By the end of the workshop participants will have:

- increased awareness of the principles underpinning sound reasoning and decision-making
- increased awareness of service design and its impact on decision-making
- increased understanding of the nature and importance of reflective practice in achieving effective decisions.

WORKSHOP OUTLINE: The workshop includes taught elements and some opportunities for group work. Broad areas covered include:

- Management of Risk and Need in the population and individuals
- Professional Duty and the stages of decision-making
- Managing the pressures on effective decision-making including personal, contextual and resource-based constraints

THIS WORKSHOP IS SUITABLE FOR:

- All practitioners in Health, Education, Social or Third Sector organisations, wishing to understand more about the principles of professional decision-making and expertise.
- Any manager in the public or private sector interested in a model which will support effective service design and governance decisions.

FACILITIES: These should be provided by the service/organisation commissioning the package and, for each workshop, should include:

- a large room (cabaret seating or big enough for break-out groups for up to 100 people)
- a data/powerpoint projector, screen and flipchart
- refreshments as appropriate
- photocopying of handouts
