

# An Introduction to The Care Aims Intended Outcomes Framework

This **1-day workshop** aims to introduce you to the Care Aims Intended Outcomes Framework in order to help you understand how it could support service transformation and enable you to make a decision about whether to proceed to implementation within your service/team/organisation. The Care Aims Framework has been adopted by a large number of services and organisations across the UK to support them transform their services to become more ethical, effective and efficient through person-centred care and clarity about duty and outcome.

**Please note: This workshop does not equip services/teams/organizations to implement the model locally. More in-depth training is required for this.**

## By the end of the workshop participants will have:

- a clear understanding of the concepts and principles underpinning the Care Aims Framework
- a clear understanding of how this approach applies to their service/caseload/client group

**WORKSHOP OUTLINE:** This workshop includes mainly taught elements and one opportunity for group work. Broad areas covered include:

- An overview of the Framework - its philosophy, origins and underlying principles
- The key benefits and impacts of using the framework to transform services
- The principles of collaborative, supported self-help and early intervention
- The principles of care management using care aims and episodes to measure intended outcome of intervention and demonstrate effectiveness
- Using care aims as a data set to support reflection, governance and organisational intelligence

## THIS WORKSHOP IS SUITABLE FOR:

- Leaders or commissioners of public services (ideally across the entire system) interested in a framework which will support effective service transformation and excellent outcomes for the public.
- Practitioners in Health, Social Care, Education, in the public, third or private sector, wishing to understand more about the Care Aims Framework and it's possible impact on collaborative practice.

**FACILITIES:** These should be provided by the service/organisation commissioning the package and, for each workshop, should include:

- a large room (cabaret seating or big enough for break-out groups for up to 100 people)
- a data/powerpoint projector, screen and flipchart
- refreshments as appropriate
- photocopying of handouts
